MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING NO. XX

B.C. HYDRO & POWER AUTHORITY (the "Employer")

And

INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS LOCAL UNION 258 (IBEW 258) (the "Union")

Re: WINDERS

WHEREAS BC Hydro relies on and values the highly-skill and specialized work performed by its Winders;

AND WHEREAS BC Hydro through it's apprenticeship program has built up the only in-house group of utility Winders in British Columbia;

AND WHEREAS BC Hydro wishes to continue to attract and retain utility Winders within it's workforce;

NOW THEREFORE, the Parties agree to the following terms, effective April 1, 2020:

- 1. All current temporary employees in the Winder classification within Construction Services will be converted to regular employee status.
- 2. All existing and newly converted regular employees in the Winder classification within Construction Services will be placed on a Modified Work Week as agreed upon by BC Hydro and the Union.
- 3. <u>BC Hydro maintains the management right to determine whether or not the Winders</u> will remain in Construction Services or be moved into another business unit.
